DESIGNATED HALLWAYS, ENTRANCES, AND EXITS WILL BE MARKED WITH PHYSICAL DISTANCING REMINDERS.

PHYSICAL BARRIERS WILL BE ADDED IN HEAVY TRAFFIC AREAS.
