As the son of one of the school's founders, Landon Thompson, Carrington kept close ties to Gaston Day School after graduating from Oak Ridge Academy. He and his family were most recently on campus in June to celebrate the school's 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary.

**Shawn Dunnagan, 1980** and members of the 1977, 1978 and 1979 women's basketball teams were inducted into the Spartan Athletic Hall of Fame on January 25. A three-sport star in her time at GDS playing volleyball, basketball, and softball, Shawn was known as a team spark plug and the consummate teammate. Shawn attended Salem College where she petitioned the school to begin a volleyball team in order to increase opportunities for females to participate in college athletics. She returned to GDS to teach PE in the late '80s and early '90s. **Shawn** was joined by her team-mates **Miriam Dixon, Lucy Doster Poche, Coach Judy Joye, Carol Doster Hannah, Catherine Carstarphen, Lee Doster Ward, Teemi Haith-**

**cox Caskey, Stephanie Rauch, Alice Stowe Matthews, and Julie Alsobrooks Dellinger** for the Hall of Fame dinner and induction ceremony. Over the course of these three seasons (all of which culminated with a state championship), the combined record of the three teams was 79-5, which was part of a five year run with an overall record of 123 wins and 10 losses, and a record-breaking streak of 98 consecutive wins in the conference. Of particular note: the 1977 team won the first state title in Gaston Day School history, and this winter commemorates the 40th anniversary of their 1979 title. Congratulations to Shawn, her team-mates, and coach Joye.
