

Gaston Day School is an independent, coeducational day school for 500 students in grades PreSchool through 12th.

This posting is for a part-time After School Lead Staff member. The Gaston Day after school staff is responsible for the safety and well-being of students ranging from 3 to 12 years of age. This includes helping students with their homework, hands-on activities, leading discussions with groups of students, conducting read-alouds to students, and assisting with the dismissal of students at the end of the day. Candidates should plan to work five days a week from 3:00pm to 6:00pm, with some flexibility in the scheduling. A competitive candidate will be reliable, hardworking, and detail oriented. Pay will range between \$20-\$25 per hour based on qualifications and experience.

Broad responsibilities:

- Oversee and manage a small number of afterschool team members.
- Effectively take attendance and record participants to all activities.
- Utilize classroom management skills to create a safe environment for all students.
- Ability to give clear directions and execute activities.
- Encourage students to interact with their peers, problem solve, and think critically.
- Assist with daily snacks and communication with parents.
- Build positive relationships with students, coworkers, and families.

- Exhibits organizational skills, self-motivation, punctuality, and collegiality.
- Effectively works independently and in a team environment.
- Displays a good work ethic while paying attention to detail.
- Loves helping students find success

- High School Diploma, GED, college experience preferred.
- Previous experience in an educational environment and/or previous experience working with children preferred.
