Rising Kindergarten

- Families should be reading daily with their children to develop strong reading habits

Rising 1st Grade

- Families should be reading daily with their children to develop strong reading habits
- Students should also be practicing reading and spelling sight words, which can be found [here](#)

Rising 2nd Grade

- Students may choose **two** of the following mystery books from these series- *Nancy Drew and the Clue Crew*, *A to Z Mysteries* or *Boxcar Children*
 - Students are asked to write a paragraph summary of the books they read for the first day of school

Rising 3rd Grade

- *The One and Only Ivan* by Katherine Applegate
- Students should also be working on addition and subtraction fact fluency

Rising 4th Grade

- One of the following Kate DiCamillo novels - *The Magician's Elephant*, *The Tiger Rising*, *The Tale of Despereaux*, *The Beatryce Prophecy*
 - Do not read *Because of Winn-Dixie* or *Flora and Ulysses* as these are read throughout the school year
- Students should also read **one additional** chapter book of their choosing
